Relation Ships

What should you bring? (recommended)

- Lunch, snacks, plenty to drink
- Cooler or insulated bag if you are bringing food
- Sunglasses and Hat/Cap
- Rubber sole shoes/sneakers/boots
- Layer attire as the temperature may change during the trip
- Water Repellant Jacket. (Windbreaker style)
- Sunscreen/ Sun Tan/Block Lotion if you are prone to sunburn
- Rod and Tackle (Will be provided. Feel free to bring your own!)
- Cooler (30qt or less) for the fish you catch. Ice can be purchased on the dock
- Dramamine or other seasickness medication if you think there is a possibility you may get seasick. You may also want to bring saltine crackers
- Hand Towel(s) for wiping your hands
- Pair of rubber/insulated gloves with a grip palm if you don't like getting your hands dirty!
- Cash (If you plan to purchase any items on the boat)

Code of Conduct (Please share this with your guests)

To ensure a safe and enjoyable day on the water, the following code of conduct must be adhered to while aboard the vessel:

- Do not bring any hard liquor
- Do not bring illegal drugs
- All children must be in direct supervision of their guardian adult
- No horseplay
- Respect and consideration toward all aboard
- Do not toss debris into ocean
- Do not bring trash cans or large metal coolers

Once out to sea the vessel is under the jurisdiction of the U.S. Coast Guard. Violation of the above will prohibit you from boarding the vessel or force the vessel to return to the pier. The Captain of the vessel makes the final decision. Relation Ships or any of its representatives have no authority to override the Captain.

Payment

Credit card payments can be made online or via telephone. Contact your host for details as well as making cash payments.

Cancellation

Refunds will be provided for cancellations made prior to August 13th in the manner as the payment. No refunds will be granted for cancellations made after August 13th.

Rain Date

It is the Captain's decision to cancel the trip due to inclement weather. If the trip is cancelled a rain date will be provided. If a rain date is not available you will receive a refund.
